Commentary: Nevada's "headline" unemployment rate remained unchanged at a seasonally-adjusted 4.1% in October 2019. Relative to October 2018, the state added 30,400 private payroll jobs (99% of the total) and the unemployment rate fell 0.3 points. YOY total job growth peaked in September 1994 at 76,400. Nevada's U-6 rate (unemployed, marginally attached and forced part-time workers) declined 0.7 points to 8.2% in Q3, 2019. Average weekly hours increased 0.4 hours and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages increased 4.9% compared to October 2018.

Commentary: The Las Vegas MSA “headline” unemployment rate remained 4% in October. Compared to October 2018, the local economy added 15,300 private payroll jobs (115% of the total) and the unemployment rate fell by 0.5 points. Total annual job growth peaked in April 2005 at 63,900. Inflation-adjusted average weekly wages increased 1.5% from October 2018. Average weekly hours worked remained unchanged compared to a year ago at 33.7. Overall, job growth in the Las Vegas area has slowed down slightly over the year and wage growth has been weak. For now, we expect continued steady economic growth around the 2% mark.

Commentary: The Reno-Sparks MSA “headline” unemployment rate declined 0.1 points to 2.8% in October. Compared to October 2018, the region created 12,300 new private payroll jobs (104% of the total) and the unemployment rate fell 0.5 points. YOY job growth peaked in December 2004 with 17,700 total jobs. Meanwhile, YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages were up 11.3% compared to October 2018. Reno-Sparks had the third highest job growth in the nation. The Reno-Sparks economy continues to grow relatively quickly, as it has for the last few years. We expect to see similar growth for the remainder of 2019.
