Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate declined to 6.8% in November. Relative to November 2020, the state gained 90,200 private payroll jobs (an 8.1% increase) and the unemployment rate declined 1.9 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.3 hours YOY, however, and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages decreased 1.8% compared to November 2020. November's improvement in unemployment is welcome, but Nevada's unemployment rate is currently the second highest in the nation, only 0.1 percentage points better than California's.
