Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate remained constant at 5% in April. Relative to April 2021, the state gained 107,100 jobs (up 8.0%); of those, 104,700 were private payroll jobs (a 8.9% increase) and the unemployment rate declined 3.6 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.6 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages decreased 0.9% compared to April 2021. Like March, Ne-

vada's economy continued to improve in April. The Leisure and Hospitality industry continued to see the most job gains at 49,800 jobs relative to last year.
