Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate declined 0.2 percentage points in June. Relative to June 2021, the state gained 90,500 total payroll jobs (up 6.6%); of those, 87,400 were private payroll jobs (a 7.3% increase) and the unemployment rate declined 2.5 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.3 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages decreased 1.3% compared to June 2021. Although the continuing decline in weekly wages is a point of concern, Nevada remains first in the nation in YOY Job Growth.
