Commentary: Nevada's unemployment rate remained stable in February 2015 after adding 6,600 jobs more than January's estimate. Relative to Feb-

ruary 2013, the Nevada economy has added 40,400 jobs and the unemploy-

ment rate has fallen by 1.3 points. Y-O-Y job growth in the first two months of 2015 has been 0.4 points slower than the same period last year. However, average weekly hours and weekly wages are up across all time periods in

February. This suggests that businesses are fairly optimistic.

to February 2014. However, February's growth has not been enough to offset the post-holiday losses yet. Additionally, average weekly hours are down 1.2 percent since February 2014, while wages are up 2.4 percent over the same

Commentary: The Reno-Sparks MSA, unlike the state and Las Vegas, is ahead of pace compared to a year ago. In February 2015, jobs were growing 1.0 percentage-point faster than in February 2014. This probably has a lot to do with the region's recent economic development success. On a Y-O-Y basis, the unemployment rate has declined by 1.4 points. Also, average weekly hours and wages are both up across all time periods, indicating that Reno's economy has gotten off to a strong start this year.
