Commentary: Nevada's unemployment rate remained 7.1 percent for the third straight month in March 2015. The economy added 5,100 jobs compared to February. Relative to February 2014, the Nevada economy has added 36,300 jobs and the unemployment rate has fallen by 1.1 points. Y-O-Y job growth in the first two months of 2015 has been 0.8 points slower than the same period last year. The first quarter of 2015 has been generally

sluggish, seeing stagnating unemployment and weekly hours worked.

This probably has a lot to do with the region's recent economic development successes. On a Y-O-Y basis, the unemployment rate has declined by 1.4 points. Also, average weekly hours and wages are also both trdning up, indicating that Reno's economy has gotten off to a strong start this year.
