in September. Compared to September 2018, the local economy added 20,300 private payroll

jobs (88% of the total) and the unemployment rate fell by 0.8 points. Total annual job growth

peaked in April 2005 at 63,900. Inflation-adjusted average weekly wages declined 0.1% from September 2018. Average weekly hours worked declined 0.7 hours compared to a year ago to 33.6. Overall, job growth in the Las Vegas area has been consistent for several years now, as it

Commentary: The Reno-Sparks MSA "headline" unemployment rate declined 0.4 points to 2.9% in September. Compared to September 2018, the region created 13,500 new private payroll jobs (102% of the total) and the unemployment rate fell 0.5 points. YOY job growth

peaked in December 2004 with 17,700 total jobs. Meanwhile, YOY average weekly inflationadjusted wages were up 10.7% compared to September 2018. Reno-Sparks had the third highest job growth in the nation. The Reno-Sparks economy continues to grow relatively quickly, as it has for the last few years. We expect to see similar growth for the remainder of 2019.
