Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate increased 0.3 points in December. Relative to December 2021, the state gained 53,400 total payroll jobs (up 3.8%); of those, 49,900 were private payroll jobs (an 4.0% increase) and the unemployment rate declined 0.1 points. Average weekly hours increased by 0.4 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages increased 1.6% compared to December 2021. Of note, the Leisure & Hospitality sector has grown for the past 4 consecutive months and has generated 18,200 jobs YOY.

Commentary: The Las Vegas MSA "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate declined 0.2 points to 5.4% in December. Compared to December 2021, the economy gained 43,300 total payroll jobs (a 4.2% increase) and the unemployment rate increased 0.4 points YOY. Inflationadjusted average weekly wages increased 0.5% while the average weekly hours worked rose 0.3 hours YOY. Both the Leisure & Hospitality and the Construction sectors have seen signifcant job gains: 16,000 jobs and 10,900 jobs, respectively. While total job growth remains strong, compared to December 2021 YOY job growth decelerated by 8.5%.

Commentary: The Reno-Sparks MSA "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate declined to by 0.1 points in December to 3.4%, or about 2/3rds of the Las Vegas rate. Compared to December 2021, the region gained 9,400 private payroll jobs (a 4.2% increase) while the unemployment rate increased 1.0 points. YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages were 7.5% higher compared to December 2021 and average weekly hours increased 0.9 hours (a 2.6% increase). Compared to Las Vegas, the Reno-Sparks MSA has seen only a 0.4% decline in YOY job growth compared to a 8.5% decline in Southern Nevada.
