Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate remained flat in June. Relative to June 2022, the state gained 60,500 total payroll jobs (up 4.1%); of those, 52,000 were private payroll jobs (a 3.9% increase) and the unemployment rate increased 0.2 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.5 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages decreased 2.4% compared to June 2022. Of note, the Leisure & Hospitality sector has grown for the past 2 consecutive months and has generated 23,700 jobs YOY.

points to 6% in June. Compared to June 2022, the economy gained 52,500 total payroll jobs (a 4.9% increase) and the unemployment rate decreased 0.2 points YOY. Inflation-adjusted average weekly wages decreased 3.5% while the average weekly hours worked decreased 0.5 hours YOY. Lesiure and Hospitality and the Professional and Business Services sectors have seen jobs gains: 19,600 jobs and 12,300 jobs respectively. While job growth may seem strong, compared to June 2022, YOY job growth declined by 0.7%.

Commentary: The Reno-Sparks MSA "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate increased by 0.4 points in June. This continues to be less than the Las Vegas rate. Compared to June 2022, the region gained 9,700 private payroll jobs (a 3.7% increase) while the unemployment rate increased 0.9 points YOY. YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages are 7.1% higher compared to June 2022 and average weekly hours increased 0.1 hours (a 0.3% increase). Compared to Las Vegas, the Reno-Sparks region has seen a 1.5% decline in YOY job growth compared to Vegas' 0.7% decline.
