Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate decreased 0.1 points in April. Relative to April 2022, the state gained 60,700 total payroll jobs (up 4.1%); of those, 52,900 were private payroll jobs (a 4.0% increase) and the unemployment rate increased 0.2 points. Average weekly hours increased by 0.1 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages increased 1.1% compared to April 2022. Of note, the Leisure & Hospitality sector has grown for the past 28 consecutive months and has generated 28,600 jobs YOY.


