Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate stayed flat in September. Relative to September 2022, the state gained 50,800 total payroll jobs (up 3.4%); of those, 44,300 were private payroll jobs (a 3.3% increase) and the unemployment rate declined 0.1 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.2 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages decreased 3.3% compared to September 2022. Of note, the Leisure & Hospitality sector has grown for the past 5 consecutive months and has generated 18,500 jobs YOY followed by Professional & Business Services with 13,600 jobs added YOY.

Compared to September 2022, the region gained 8,300 private payroll jobs (a 3.1% increase) while the unemployment rate declined 0.8 points YOY. YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages are 4.9% higher compared to September 2022 and average weekly hours increased 0.9 hours (a 2.7% increase). Compared to Las Vegas, the Reno-Sparks region has seen a 2.1% decline in YOY job growth compared to Vega's 2.0% decline.
