Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate remained flat in January. Relative to January 2023, the state gained 57,100 total payroll jobs (up 3.8%); of those, 47,300 were private payroll jobs (an 3.5% increase) and the unemployment rate increased 0.1 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 1.0 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages decreased 5.9% compared to January 2023. Of note, the Construction sector has grown for the past 6 consecutive months and has generated 8,500 jobs YOY.

Commentary: The Las Vegas MSA "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate increased 0.1

points to 5.4% in January. Compared to January 2023, the economy gained 37,900 total payroll

jobs (a 3.5% increase) and the unemployment rate decreased 0.4 points YOY. Inflation-adjust-

ed average weekly wages decreased 6.2% while the average weekly hours worked declined by 1.3 hours YOY. The Lesiure and Hospitality and the Government sector have seen jobs gains: 11,200 jobs and 7,500 jobs respectively. While job growth may seem strong, compared to Janu-

Compared to January 2023, the region gained 10,300 private payroll jobs (a 4.0% increase) while the unemployment rate decreased 0.1 points YOY. YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages down 4.2% compared to January 2023 and average weekly hours decreased 0.3 hours (a 0.9% decrease). Compared to Las Vegas, the Reno-Sparks region has only seen a 0.7% increase in YOY job growth compared to Vegas' 0.3% decline.
