Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate increased 0.1 points in August. Relative to August 2023, the state gained 46,800 total payroll jobs (up 3.0%); of those, 35,900 were private payroll jobs (a 2.6% increase) and the unemployment rate increased 0.4 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.4 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages increased 0.8% compared to September 2023. Of note, the Construction sector has grown for the past 6 consecutive months. The Construction sector has grown the most YoY in terms of total jobs and has generated 12,700 jobs YOY.

Commentary: The Reno-Sparks MSA "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate decreased by

0.4 points in August. This continues to be less than the Las Vegas rate. Compared to August 2023, the region gained 6,100 total payroll jobs (up 2.3%); of those, 4,900 were private payroll

jobs (a 2.1% increase) while the unemployment rate increased 0.5 points YOY. YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages are 0.6% lower compared to August 2023 and average weekly hours increased 0.9 hours (a 2.6% increase). Compared to Las Vegas, the Reno-Sparks

region has seen a 1.0% decline in YOY job growth compared to Vegas' 0.1% decrease.
