Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate increased 0.1 points in October. Relative to October 2023, the state gained 20,000 total payroll jobs (up 1.3%); of those, 16,000 were private payroll jobs (a 1.2% increase) and the unemployment rate grew by 0.4 points. Average weekly hours decreased by 0.3 hours YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages improved 2.4% compared to October 2023. Of note, the Other Services sector has grown for the past 5 consecutive months. The Construction sector has grown the most YoY in terms of total jobs and has generated 8,300 jobs YOY.

YOY average weekly inflation-adjusted wages are 3.3% lower compared to October 2023 and average weekly hours grew by 0.7 hours (a 2.6% increase). The Education & Health Services sector has grown for 4 consecutive months and has increased by 1,800 jobs YOY. Additionally, the region has seen a 2.6% decline in YOY job growth.
