Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment decreased 0.1 points in May. Relative to May 2024, the state gained 6,800 total payroll jobs (up 0.4%); of those, 3,900 were private payroll jobs (a 0.3% increase) and the unemployment rate was flat. Average weekly hours remained flat YOY and average weekly inflation-adjusted wages increased 4.0% compared to May 2024. Of note, the Education & Health Services sector has grown for the past 5 months. The Education and Health Services sector has also grown the

most YoY in terms of total jobs and has generated 8,300 jobs YOY.

Commentary: The Las Vegas MSA "headline" (minimum) unemployment rate increased 0.3 points to 5.5% in May. Compared to May 2024, the region gained 3,000 total payroll jobs (up 0.3%); of those, 1,100 were private payroll jobs (a 0.1% increase) and the unemployment rate remained flat YOY. Inflation-adjusted average weekly wages grew 4.1% while the average weekly hours worked declined 0.4 hours YOY. Both the Education & Health Services and the Leisure & Hospitality sectors have seen jobs gains: 4,000 jobs and 800 jobs respectively. With

job growth declining, compared to May 2024, YOY job growth has decreased by 0.7%.
