Commentary: Nevada's seasonally-adjusted "headline" (minimum) unemployment decreased 0.1 ppt in August. Relative to August 2024, the state lost 100 total payroll jobs (-0.0%); of those, 1,800 were private payroll jobs (a 0.1% decrease) and the unemployment rate decreased 0.4 points. Average weekly hours grew by 0.5 hours YOY and average weekly inflationadjusted wages increased 4.5% compared to August 2024. Of note, the Government sector has grown for the past 2 months. The Education and Health Services sector has grown the most YoY in terms of total jobs and has generated 6,200 jobs YOY.
